PORT MEDICAL AESTHETICS CLINIC (PMAC) VIP CHARITY EVENT – RAISING FUNDS FOR LIBERTY DOMESTIC AND FAMILY VIOLENCE SPECIALIST SERVICES

After months of hard work by my team at PMAC, some incredibly generous sponsors and the community, the charity auction went from a small idea in my head to a 150-person invitation-only VIP cocktail party. Hello Sailor, the venue, generously created a custom cocktail for the event 'The ToxTail' and donated the proceeds of cocktail sales

for the whole month of February to Liberty Services.

Essentially, I wanted to create an event to give those community members who do support causes a platform to donate, where their money could count the most.

We are so lucky to live in such a generous and community-minded part of the world, and

this event was a culmination of the desire to help and the means to get it done in a thoughtful and productive way.

The entire evening surpassed my expectations. I am very very proud of what we were able to achieve.

Congratulations Dr Kristy on running such an amazing event. Can you tell us where the idea came from to host such an event?

Thank you! My team and I are absolutely blown away by the support and generosity of the community here in Port Macquarie.

I am a General Practitioner at Port Macquarie GPs and have unfortunately witnessed the impact COVID, coupled with the lack of affordable housing, has had on the vulnerable in our community, especially women and their children. Some of my

patients have directly accessed the services provided by Liberty, and so I have seen first hand just how important their work is. I wanted to show my support for their valuable work and to thank them for helping me to care for some of my most vulnerable patients.

I had an idea; for PMAC (my cosmetic clinic, where I work when I am not working as a GP) to host a charity event, with all money raised donated directly to Liberty



The charity that the event was created around was Liberty Domestic and Family Violence Specialist Services. For those who aren't familiar with this charity can you give us a bit of background about who they are and what they do?

Liberty Domestic and Family Violence Specialist Services is a not-for-profit organisation providing specialist support and housing services to women and families affected by domestic and family violence and homelessness in the Port Macquarie-Hastings region. The organisation was formed in 1980 as the Hastings Women and Children's Refuge and has since evolved and expanded to provide a wide range of services to those in need of domestic violence and homelessness support.

Last financial year Liberty supported 1200 women and children experiencing domestic and family violence in our local community through support groups, outreach services, housing, crisis accommodation and after-hours responses.

Tell us about how the event unfolded, who attended, was there a theme, where was it held?

ToxTails was held at Hello Sailor on a Friday evening. Despite the threat of rain that evening we had an incredible turnout.

The dress code was "dress to impress". We really wanted to give people a chance to dress up, kick on some heels and enjoy



an elegant event – especially after two years of being stuck inside.

The evening started at 6pm. Guests were greeted and checked in under a bespoke foliage and balloon archway, created specifically for the event by local florist Bungalow & Co (one of the major sponsors of the night). Guests walked down the pink carpet to find a number of intriguing and fun pop-up games, canapes catered by Hello Sailor and Bills Fishhouse and, of course, the signature cocktail, the ToxTail.

To give guests an interactive and fun way to donate, three pop-up stations hosted various games, each with a different dollar donation.

A "Buy A Box" Stall: essentially a lucky dip for grown-ups! For either \$50 or \$100, you could purchase a box and collect the prize inside. All of these prizes were donated by generous local businesses.

No event is complete without a raffle, so for \$20, you could purchase a ticket to win

over \$1000 worth of skincare products from The Skincare Company.

The "Pop a Balloon" stall: For \$10 you could pop a balloon for the chance of winning a \$250 Stunned Mullet Voucher. Every popped

balloon contained a voucher to a local business too!

Custom made coasters donated by Snap Port Macquarie had a special QR code on it (created gratis by Cloud Concepts) to allow guests to give even if they didn't win an auction item; as well as a link on social media for those unable to attend.


We also hosted a PMAC photo booth, which turned out to be one of the most popular activities of the evening. Everyone looked so amazing.
